

LifeLink appeal this weekend

The Perth Archbishop's annual LifeLink appeal will be held in parishes this weekend to support the Archdiocese's 13 social welfare groups.

Thousands of copies of Archbishop Barry Hickey's appeal letter have been sent to regular contributors and others were distributed in parishes last weekend.

Donors can send their contributions direct to LifeLink in the envelopes provided, or they can use the special envelopes to leave their gift with their parish.

Contributions above \$2 are tax deductible and receipts will be provided to those who put their

name and address on the form. Archbishop Hickey has set a target of \$400,000 for this year's appeal, and has asked all Catholics to consider LifeLink the best way to express their faith through love for those in our own community who need help.

The LifeLink agencies assist more than 50,000 Western Australian families and individuals each year, regardless of their race, colour or creed.

Archbishop Hickey has described the annual LifeLink appeal as the best way can show our unity as a Church in order to achieve more than would be possible otherwise.
