

Archbishop's 2022 LifeLink Day for Primary Schools



2022 LifeLink Day - PROJECT GUIDE

1. Create a school display or individual classroom displays to be presented prominently for everyone in your school to see and discover.

The display or displays should include artworks and written information which highlights the work of LifeLink, and the social service agencies supported through LifeLink.



The displays should respond in part to these core questions: -

How does the Church respond to our brothers and sisters in need through LifeLink?

Why is caring for those who are less fortunate an important part of Faith?

What do people in need, need most from us?

There is a wealth of information and photos available on the LifeLink website.

In addition, the display or displays should promote the special fundraising event or activity which your school (or classes within said school) will undertake.

Promote what your school will do as its chosen fundraising activity and when this will be held?

Please note: Whilst the Archbishop will officially launch LifeLink Day on Wednesday 8 June 2022, schools may choose to conduct their LifeLink Day plans at any time during the school year.

2. Each display or displays are requested to be produced in A3 size however they may be larger if preferred.

Schools may choose to produce one large collage of individual displays from each class, or have one smaller displayed in each class.

- 3. Please send a photo or short video of your school's creation/s to the Archbishop.
 - Photos are requested in a high-resolution jpeg format please.
 - Videos should be no more than 30 seconds duration please.
